INTRODUCTION

What is the scholarship?

It is a sum of money, paid in two installments (or three for the first years of a bachelor's degree and a single-cycle master's degree with enrollment by October 31, 2026), awarded through a public competition to university students, enrolled full-time or part-time at Piedmontese universities, in possession of the economic and merit requirements indicated in the competition announcement for the academic year 2026/27.

What is the housing service?

The housing service consists of a bed, assigned by Edisu and not chosen by the students, in one of the university residences in Turin or in some cities in Piedmont where university courses are held.

The requirements for applying for the scholarship and housing service are the same. The application deadline is also the same. However, the publication dates of the rankings are different.

STEP 1

CHECK IF YOU MEET THE REQUIREMENTS

Before applying for a scholarship only or a scholarship and housing benefit for the 2026/27 academic year, you must verify that you meet the financial and merit requirements set out in the competition announcement.

Access requirements

If you enroll in the first year of a bachelor's or single-cycle master's degree program in the 2026/27 academic year, you will be required to have a high school diploma, regardless of grade, and to enroll in the program by the deadlines set by your university, and in any case no later than October 31, 2026 (to be included in the rankings of November 9, 2026) or November 30, 2026 (to be included in the final rankings of December 16, 2026). If you do not enroll by November 30, 2026, you will be "suspended" (unless there are other reasons for exclusion), but you may enroll by April 2, 2027, to be included in the final rankings of April 30, 2027.

If you are enrolling in the first year of a master's degree program in the 2026/27 academic year, the only requirement is that you enroll in a master's degree program in Piedmont by November 30, 2026, to be included in the final rankings of December 16, 2026, or by April 2, 2027, to be included in the final rankings of April 30, 2027, pursuant to Article 11, paragraph 2 of the competition announcement. For confirmation of merit-based benefits, please consult Article 9, paragraph 1 of the competition announcement.

Please note: If you were already enrolled in the Italian university system in previous academic years and are transferring, you CANNOT apply as a first-year student and must apply as a subsequent year. Please read Article 15, paragraph 4 of the call for applications carefully.

Please note: If you enroll in the first year of Medicine and Surgery (LM-41), Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics (LM-46), or Veterinary Medicine (LM-42), or a similar program, after completing the filter semester, follow the provisions of Article 9, paragraph 3, of the competition announcement.

Economic requirements

They are identified on the basis of the economic and financial condition of your family unit.
At the time of submitting the application, you must have a valid ISEE (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator) for the right to university education for the applicant, based on income earned in 2024 and assets held as of December 31, 2024. The certificate must not contain any omissions or discrepancies. For further information, see Article 6 of the competition announcement.

The EDISU benefit application can be completed with only the receipt certifying the DSU subscription at the CAAF, without having to have the relevant certification processed by INPS. However, the University ISEE certification must be processed by INPS by the application deadline, failing which students will be excluded from the provisional rankings. This situation can be remedied later by filing a formal appeal.

For independent student status, please refer to the provisions of Article 6, paragraph 1.5 of the 2026/27 Call for Applications.



In the event of significant changes in income following adverse events, INPS offers citizens the option of calculating a Current ISEE. For more information, please refer to Article 6, paragraph 3 of the 2026/27 Competition Notice.

For the 2026/27 academic year, and to retrieve ISEE University data, Edisu Piemonte will electronically download the latest ISEE certificate from the INPS database for 2026. After retrieving the ISEE, Edisu will send a receipt ('INPS DATA Receipt') containing the ISEE data retrieved from the INPS database to the email address you provided when completing the scholarship application. This receipt will be sent within 48 business hours of receiving the email with the subject "Receipt of Application."



Please note that the University ISEE is not issued immediately and therefore Edisu is in no way responsible for the failure to transmit the data contained in the DSU and/or processing of the University ISEE for the 2026/27 academic year benefit request.



Edisu checks 100% of the self-certifications of scholarship recipients. Inaccurate statements will result in the refund of the scholarship and penalties, so pay close attention to the declarations you make regarding your financial situation.

STEP 2

FIND OUT THE AMOUNTS

If you meet the financial and merit requirements indicated in the announcement, check which student category you fall into and which application you can submit. The scholarship amount varies depending on the financial situation and the type of student.

Types for stock market purposes

You can be "on-site", "commuting" or "off-site":

- You are **eligible** for a scholarship if you are resident in the same municipality as your program.
- You are **a commuter** if you live in a municipality other than the one where your course of study is located, which can be reached by public transportation within 60 minutes. You can apply for the scholarship only.
- You are **a non-resident** if you live in a municipality other than the one where your course of study is located, which cannot be reached by public transportation within 60 minutes, or if you are independent pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1.5 of the competition announcement. You can apply for the scholarship and housing service or the scholarship alone.

Travel time is calculated using the times defined by the transport companies. These times are taken from the Muoversi in Piemonte system (the reference for the Piedmont Region) and similar tracking systems such as Google and train timetables on local transport websites.



The routes considered are those between the train or bus station in your municipality of residence and the one in your study location, in addition to any walking route between two stops. Only routes that ensure, as quickly as possible, your arrival in the municipality where your study program is located by 8:00 a.m. and your return to your municipality of residence by 8:00 p.m. will be considered. For the Municipality of Turin, the reference station is the first arrival/ departure station on the route in question. For the Municipality of Milan, the reference station is Central Station.

Only the Municipalities are observed and any localities and hamlets belonging to them are not taken into consideration.

Amounts for full-time students

You can also apply for this scholarship if you have received an INPS scholarship for free accommodation in a university residence.

You are also eligible for this scholarship: 1. if you have requested

housing and are ranked among the final housing candidates but refuse the accommodation during the online acceptance process, fail to submit the acceptance procedure, or if you renounce the accommodation when the residence is assigned (or fail to show up at the assigned residence within the required timeframe);

2. if you have requested the accommodation service and you give up the bed-space after checking in, even if the bed-space has been assigned to you for scrolling;

3. if you are a winner of an INPS scholarship or other type of scholarship for the assignment of a bed-space in a university college with payment of part of the fee;

4. if you fall into the "out of town" category based on the municipality of residence, but do not submit a suitable declaration of accommodation as a expensive or you decide not to pay for paid accommodation at the course location.

You will be eligible for this scholarship amount only if:

1. You do NOT request housing services; 2.

You request housing services, but cancel your request by 12 noon on September 4, 2026; 3. You request housing services but submit a

"renunciation of bed space" by 12 noon on September 16, 2026, via a complaint;

4. is excluded from the final ranking for housing services but is a winner in the final ranking for scholarships;

5. you are eligible in the final ranking for housing services but declare that you are not interested during the declaration of interest stage or you do not submit the declaration of interest procedure or you renounce the bed-space assigned during the "declaration of interest results" stage or you are not "assigned" a bed-space during the declaration of interest results stage despite having declared your interest

6. You are a winner or eligible in the final ranking for housing services and have completed the acceptance or declaration of interest form with:

- the Erasmus Option with a stay abroad of 8 months or more (you must remember to self-certify that you have taken accommodation in payment according to the methods and timeframes indicated in art. 8 paragraph 2 of the competition announcement) or
- the Renato Einaudi Option (you do not have to self-certify that you have paid for accommodation as checks are carried out directly with the facility);

7. You request housing but attend a course location that does not offer EDISU residences (you do not need to submit a declaration of interest, but you must self-certify that you have paid accommodation);



Please note that to apply for the scholarship amount indicated here, you must self-certify that you have paid accommodation according to the deadlines and procedures indicated in Article 8, paragraph 2 of the competition announcement. Otherwise, if you are awarded the scholarship, you will be paid the amount established for commuter students.

You can apply for this amount even if you are an independent student pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 5.1 of the competition announcement. You do not have to:

Submit the declaration of paid accommodation, but you must attach the rental agreement or the deed of purchase directly to the application.

If you receive this amount in the final ranking, but you also requested housing and the bed is assigned to you through a rollover during the year and you accept it, the value of the housing service, calculated at €245.45 per month, will be deducted from the scholarship amount. For more information, see Article 33, paragraph 3.1 of the competition announcement.

If you are enrolled [part-time](#), please consult Article 5, paragraph 2 of the competition announcement and remember that you can only apply for the scholarship.

Please remember that the disbursement of the amount due is subject to the "winner" status in the final scholarship rankings.

What happens if I enroll in two courses?

A 20% increase in the scholarship value is expected for simultaneous enrollment in a second full-time course.

The increase is not due if you lose the eligibility for the scholarship and/or if you lose the eligibility for the increase itself.

The request for a 20% increase must be submitted when completing the scholarship application, in the "School Data" section, or it can be added by modifying the "Second Degree Course" data by the application deadline (as per Article 7, paragraph 5 of the Competition Notice).

If you are successful and meet the requirements for the second installment, the increase will be paid simultaneously with the second installment of the scholarship (but with separate payments). In fact, if you are enrolled in a first year in both the major for which you are requesting benefits and the minor for which you are requesting the increase, you must earn 20 credits in both majors by August 10, 2026.

However, if the increase is requested for a subsequent year, the merit requirements as of August 10, 2026, indicated in Annex A2 of the announcement, cannot be achieved using bonus credits.

Attention: you cannot request the increase for simultaneous enrolment in the first year of Medicine and Surgery (LM-41), Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics (LM-46) or Veterinary Medicine (LM-42) and the "related course"

Information regarding the types and amounts of scholarships is available in Articles 4 and 5 of the competition announcement.

STEP 3

SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION BY THE DEADLINE

Applications can be submitted starting from July 22, 2026 and strictly by:

September 4, 2026, 12:00 PM



If you are not yet formally enrolled at the University, you must still submit your application by the indicated deadline. Please note that you must complete your enrollment by the dates indicated in Article 9, paragraph 1 of the announcement. Failure to enroll will result in exclusion from the competition.



If you enroll in the "filter semester" for enrollment in Medicine and Surgery (LM-41), Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics (LM-46) or Veterinary Medicine (LM-42) in a Piedmontese university you must still submit an application by the deadline indicating one of these courses and NOT the "similar course"

After verifying that you meet the requirements and the type of application you wish to submit, you can proceed with the application by accessing the online Scholarship, Accommodation, Meals, Reimbursements and Contributions service at www.edisu.piemonte.it using your SPID or CIE (Italian Personal Identification Number) or, if you are an international student without Italian residency, your Temporary Access Code for the 2026/27 academic year.

[SPID about CIE](#)

If you are an adult and have an Italian identity document (ID card, passport, driving license), you MUST submit the application by accessing the procedure within the online service exclusively with [SPID](#) or [CIE](#) (Law 100/2020).

If you are a student or an international student and you are resident in Italy you must request the Italian electronic identity card (CIE) or request the SPID

1. Fill out the online application in all required fields.
2. Submit your application exclusively online by clicking the "Submit" button by 12 noon on the deadline day.

Edisu cannot provide assistance if you have problems with your SPID: you must contact the appropriate authority for issuing it.

[Temporary access code for the academic year 2026/27](#)

The Temporary Access Code is a code you can request starting in July 2026 and expires annually (expires in June of the following year). It can be requested and used exclusively by international students who are not resident in Italy and, therefore, cannot request SPID activation.

In this case, you must carefully follow all the steps indicated in Article 7, paragraph 1.2 of the competition announcement.



Applications submitted using methods even partially different from those indicated in the competition announcement will not be accepted.

The online application must always be submitted by 12:00 noon on the deadline day. This procedure closes automatically at 12:00 noon on that day, and the countdown is reset.

After 12:00 PM, you will not be able to submit your application, even if the failure to submit is due to force majeure or third-party actions (e.g., problems with your internet connection or the device you are using).

After submitting your application, two receipts will be sent to the email address you provided.

1. The first receipt, with the subject "Data acquisition via web," is sent following the online submission of the application.
2. The second receipt, with the subject "Receipt of application," is sent following the import of the application into the EDISU database.

The application is considered successfully submitted if and only if the first receipt is received. Receipts will remain available on the student's personal page in the Online Help Desk, under "Receipts."

Students who entered the ISEE University protocol or the DSU issuance protocol during the application process will receive another receipt with the subject "INPS data receipt" within 48 working hours of the second receipt.

STEP 4

CHECK THE RANKINGS

Please note that this is a public competition: after submitting your application, you must wait for the rankings to be published. You can view them on your personal page at the online service on the dates indicated in the following tables.

If you have applied for a scholarship and housing service, you will need to consult the housing service rankings first, then those for the scholarship.

For each benefit, Edisu first publishes the provisional rankings and then the definitive rankings.

Remember to always check the provisional ranking results, as they will provide you with initial confirmation of your eligibility (i.e., whether you meet the requirements and have submitted your application in good standing) or inform you of any reasons for exclusion.

Following the publication of the provisional ranking, you will have the opportunity to file a complaint to inform Edisu of any changes to the information on the ranking or to address any reasons for exclusion.

Please note: Edisu will evaluate your complaints, but will not provide you with immediate feedback; you will have to wait for the final rankings to be published to know the final outcome and whether your complaint has been accepted or rejected. Please fill out your complaints carefully!

If you are listed as "suspended for the filter semester" in the final December rankings, it means you have requested benefits for the first year of Medicine and Surgery (LM-41), Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics (LM-46), or Veterinary Medicine (LM-42). You will be included in the provisional rankings on March 17, 2027. You can submit an appeal from March 17 to 23, 2027, at 12:00 PM. New final rankings will be published on April 16, 2027. If you are listed as "suspended," you will be included in the rankings for all "suspended" students as indicated below.

If you are "suspended" in the final rankings of December or March, you still have the opportunity to apply for the scholarship. You will be included in the provisional rankings of March 19, 2027. You can submit an appeal from March 19 to April 2, 2027, at 12:00 PM. New final rankings will be published on April 30, 2027.

Remember to complete your enrollment by April 2, 2027, otherwise you will be permanently excluded!

Further information regarding the rankings and complaints is available in Article 12 of the competition announcement.

STEP 5

ACCEPTANCE AND DECLARATION OF INTEREST

If you are the winner in the final ranking of housing services, it means that you have been assigned a bed-space in one of the EDISU residences. You must then complete and submit the "acceptance" form. If you are eligible, it means that it was not possible to assign you a bed due to availability. However, you must remember to complete and submit the "declaration of interest."

Winners: Acceptance of bed space

If you have requested housing and are listed as a winner in the final rankings, you must accept the accommodation using the specific procedure available on your personal page of the online service.

From September 25th to 29th 2026 at 12:00 PM

When filling out the acceptance form you will have to select one of the following options:

1. I accept;
2. I accept with the "Erasmus Option" (art. 33 paragraph 4 of the call);
3. I accept with the "Renato Einaudi Option" (art. 33 paragraph 5 of the announcement);
4. rejection

If you accept or agree with the "Erasmus Option", you will have to express your order of preference for all the Edisu Residences present in the procedure. In the following days, you will receive a receipt email from noreply@edisu-piemonte.it, which will provide you with all the necessary information to come to the residence for room assignment.

If you select "Refuse" or do not submit the application, you will be considered a "commuter" student for the purposes of determining the scholarship amount.

Eligible: Declaration of interest

If you have requested housing and are considered eligible in the final rankings, you must express your interest in a bed by completing the online declaration of interest within the deadlines indicated in the table below.

From September 25th to 29th 2026 at 12:00 PM

When completing the declaration of interest, you will have to select one of the following options:

1. I am interested;
2. I am interested in the "Erasmus Option" (art. 33 paragraph 4 of the call);
3. I am interested in the "Renato Einaudi Option" (art. 33 paragraph 5 of the notice);
4. I'm not interested.

If you declare that you are interested or are interested in the Erasmus Option, you will have to express your order of preference for all the Edisu Residences present in the procedure.

If you select "I'm not interested" or do not complete and submit the application, you will no longer be contacted if spaces become available at Edisu residences. However, you will be considered an "out-of-town" student for the purposes of determining the scholarship amount if you submit the paid accommodation declaration according to the methods and by the deadlines indicated in Article 8 of the Call for Applications.



The Online Acceptance/Declaration of Interest is considered correctly completed and submitted if and only if you receive an email receipt with a PDF of the completed form attached. The receipt is also available on your personal page at the EDISU Online Help Desk, in the "Receipts" section.

If, upon checking the receipt, you discover that you have made any errors in the form, you will be able to make ONLY ONE change to the data online within the deadline for submitting the Online Acceptance/Declaration of Interest.

Single scrolling rankings

After the declaration of interest has closed, the outcome of the declaration of interest will be published on **October 1, 2026**, and can be accessed by accessing the housing service ranking from your personal page on the EDISU Online Help Desk.

At the same time, on October 1, 2026, new rankings will be published for eligible students who expressed interest but were unable to be assigned a place at the time of their application. These rankings are called "Single Sliding Rankings."

If any spaces become available, the Housing Services Department will contact students in order of ranking by sending an email from assegnazione@edisu-piemonte.it to the email address they provided in their application.

Information regarding acceptance and the declaration of interest is available in Article 33 of the competition announcement.

STEP 6

DECLARE THE DATA OF A PAID ACCOMMODATION

If you are a student or an out-of-town student, you are not a guest of an EDISU residence and you belong to one of the categories listed in art. 5 paragraph 1.3 of the competition announcement, if you wish to compete for the amount envisaged for "out-of-town" students, you are required to take paid accommodation (for a fee), at the university you attend (or in a neighboring municipality - list of municipalities available on the website), using public residential facilities or private or institutional accommodation for at least 10 months in total of the 2026/27 academic year, including the period from September 1, 2026 to September 30, 2027, and to complete the appropriate self-certification online.

Otherwise, you will be considered a "commuter" for the purposes of determining the scholarship amount.

Upon submitting your data online, Edisu will send you a receipt via email with the subject "Self-certification of paid accommodation." The receipt is also available on your personal page at the EDISU Online Help Desk, in the "Receipts" section.

*If you are a first-year undergraduate or graduate student who did NOT enroll by October 31st or were deemed "eligible" but not a winner in the final rankings of November 9th, the procedure will reopen from November 9th to 19th, 2026, at 12:00 pm.

Furthermore, from March 19th to April 9th 2027 at 12:00 pm you can submit the declaration of paid accommodation if you have not submitted it before and:

- you were the winner in the rankings of November 9, 2026 and the rental contract was registered after October 31, 2026;
- you are in the rankings of December 16, 2026 and the rental contract is registered after November 15, 2026.

For these categories of students, submitting the declaration in this window allows for the integration of the "commuter" amount to the "non-resident" amount, subject to the availability of funds and the positive outcome of the checks.

When filling out the form, you must indicate the duration and type of residence, choosing between:

1. Rental contract (apartment/room): remember that it is mandatory to attach the registration receipt issued by the Rental Agency
Entries in PDF format;
2. Different onerous title (college/boardings school/pension house/social housing): remember that it is mandatory to attach the contract (or document of assignment) released by the facility in PDF format;
3. Foreign contract (international mobility): remember that it is mandatory to attach the contract in PDF format.



Independent students should refer to Article 6, paragraph 5.1 of the competition announcement.

Students attending the "filter semester" for one of the degree programs belonging to the LM-41, LM-42, or LM-46 classes must self-certify paid accommodation between March 17 and March 31, 2027, at 12:00 PM, in order to be considered "non-resident" in the final rankings of April 16, 2027. Please read Article 8, paragraph 3 of the competition announcement carefully for more information.

If you declare a contract that does not cover the entire required minimum period of 10 months, including contracts with tacit renewal, you will be in competition Only for the "commuter" amount. However, if financial resources are available, you can obtain a supplement to the out-of-town amount by submitting a specific supplementary tax return from March 19, 2027, to 12:00 noon on April 9, 2027.

If you are awarded an "out-of-town" grant and change your accommodation during the year after submitting your tax return, you must update your information using the online "Lease Change" procedure from February 15th to June 15th, 2027, at 12:00 PM.

STEP 7

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Provide your IBAN

Remember to provide a SEPA IBAN in your name or jointly in your name using the appropriate procedure available on your personal online counter page.

We recommend that you notify us immediately after submitting your application so you don't forget! Remember that without your bank details, if you win, we won't be able to pay you the scholarship!

Payment methods and times

If you are awarded a scholarship in the final rankings, you will receive the benefit in two installments:

1. An initial 50% of the total amount is automatically paid as per the following table:

If you do not provide your IBAN by December 14th or are "suspended due to enrollment in the filter semester" in the December rankings and are successful in the April 16th, 2027 rankings, you can provide your IBAN by April 13th, 2027. The first installment will be paid starting from the end of April 2027.

Only if you are "suspended" in the December or March rankings can you communicate your IBAN by May 10, 2027 and, if you are a winner in the April 30, 2027 rankings, the first instalment will be paid starting from the end of May 2027.

2. A second installment, equal to the remaining 50% of the total amount, is paid based on when the merit requirements are achieved and, if requested, self-certified as per the following table:

*For students suspended in December, the self-certification process opens on April 30, 2027, with the publication of the final rankings. **Completing the procedure is, however, recommended, especially for students with validation documents.

Please note that the payment of the instalment marks the start of the administrative process, which concludes the following month with Edisu's payment order to the credit institution indicated in the IBAN provided by the students.

The funds may therefore be available on your current account within the following days, depending on the timeframes of each individual credit institution.

Any 20% increase in the amount awarded, in the event of enrollment in a second course and achievement of the required scholarship credits, will be paid as per the table in Article 13, paragraph 4.1 of the competition announcement.

STEP 8

MEET THE MERIT REQUIREMENTS

To maintain your scholarships, receive the second installment of your scholarship, or maintain your eligibility, as a first-year student, you must meet the merit requirements during the year. Please note that competitive scholarships are awarded if you meet both the financial and merit requirements.

Merit requirements for the second installment

If you are a scholarship winner, remember that to receive the second installment, you must earn and register the number of university training credits (CFU) indicated in the following table by August 10, 2027 at the latest:

20 credits	Full-time students enrolled in a bachelor's degree, master's degree, or single-cycle master's degree program.
11 credits	Part-time students enrolled in undergraduate, graduate, or single-cycle master's degree programs.

Credits must be earned and duly registered by the Student Office of your Department with a date equal to or prior to August 10, 2027.

When calculating your merit requirements, you will not be able to take into account credits deriving from educational debts and ongoing modules that require further additions for the final grade, credits deriving from individual courses/teachings not recognized for the degree program attended, additional credits, credits validated by foreign studies, and credits deriving from the 24/60 credits course for teacher training.

August 10, 2027, is the final deadline to meet and register the merit requirements and not lose your right to the second installment. However, if you earn the credits early, you can self-certify them to receive the second installment early, as indicated in STEP 7 above and in Article 13, paragraph 4 of the competition announcement.

You will still retain the right to the first installment already received, without having to repay anything to Edisu if you do not obtain the required number of credits by August 10, 2027, but obtain them by November 30, 2027.

Please note: If you meet the indicated merit requirements, you are entitled to a waiver or refund of university fees and the regional tax, based on the provisions of your university's fee regulations.

Merit requirements for maintaining eligibility

If you are eligible in the final scholarship ranking, you must still earn and register the indicated number of credits by November 30, 2027, to maintain your benefits, including the right to a tuition fee exemption or reimbursement, in accordance with your University's Tuition Fee Regulations.



If you are considered "eligible" in the final rankings of December 16th, you may be included in a new ranking following the possible allocation of new funds. All relevant information will be published on the institutional website www.edisu.piemonte.it



If you are a student eligible for a scholarship but have been assigned housing, you will find all the information you need to maintain your benefits in Article 13, paragraph 6.1 of the competition announcement.

Revocation of the scholarship and housing service

Starting in January 2028, Edisu will carry out checks with the universities to verify the number of credits earned as of November 30, 2027. If these checks show that the required requirements have not been met, your scholarship will be revoked and the first installment will be refunded.

If you have also or only used the housing service in the Edisu Residences, you will have to return the lump sum of €2,700.00. (if the stay lasted 11 months) or €8.18 per day if assigned for a shorter period.
